

GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

National Association of Women in Construction

San Antonio Chapter

Eligibility Requirements:

1. 3.0 grade average on a 4.0 grading system.
2. Full time student (minimum of 12 hours).
3. Construction related field or major.
4. Personal interview may be requested as deemed necessary by the scholarship committee.
5. Recipient must be a Texas resident and/or a recipient attending a Texas school.

Scholarships to be awarded:

1. Budgeted monies are to be paid on a per semester basis as approved by the scholarship committee.
2. New recipient(s) will be chosen if prior recipient(s) do not meet all eligibility requirements.
3. Previous scholarship recipient(s) will be given priority.
4. Funds shall be paid directly to the school or jointly to the recipient and the school. Under no circumstances are the funds to be paid directly to the recipient only.
5. The scholarship committee will determine the number of scholarships to be awarded and the amounts given per scholarship, based upon available funds.

Scholarship Applicants are to provide the Following Information:

1. A current transcript. Previous recipient(s) need only show current report card after once being awarded the scholarship.
2. San Antonio Chapter NAWIC scholarship application. Previous recipient shall submit the previous semester's grade report and a bill and/or receipt of the following semester's classes.
3. Letters of recommendations, etc. These letters only need to be sent to the chapter at the time of first application.
4. Previous recipient(s) shall submit at the end of each semester, a brief summary to be read at the monthly stating use and benefits of this scholarship toward their education.
